1. **Rhymes**—Say a word with the same ending-sound as each of these words.
Examples: “up-pup” and “man-pan.”

up	man	we	cat	pop	lip
dig	tail	rug	sit	pick	late
shine	back	mouse	bunch	mouth	park

2. **Opposites**—Say a word opposite to each of these words. 
Examples: “up-down” and “in-out.”

up	in	hot	dark	loud	short
thick	front	under	on	heavy	poor
back	near	straight	frown	dirty	young

3. **Synonyms**—Say a word with a similar meaning to each of these words.
Examples: rug-carpet” and “house-home.”

strong	rug	under	heavy	loud	begin
job	chair	house	tired	yell	hat
dad	nice	happy	fast	big	gift

Make Reading Easy—Get Speedy!

1. Read a word in Set 1, and say a word that rhymes.
Work your speed up to 70 bpm.
2. Play Set 2, and Set 3 as written above on-beat.
3. Now, point to random words from all 3 sets, and child says answers on-beat.
